

DB094: VSV-g (E11)

Background:

VSV-g is an epitope tag composed of an 11 residue peptide, YTDIEMNRLGK, derived from the Vesicular Stomatitis viral glycoprotein.

Origin:

VSV-g (E11) is provided as an affinity purified rabbit polyclonal antibody, raised against a peptide derived from the Vesicular Stomatitis viral glycoprotein.

Product Details:

Each vial contains 200 μ g/ml of affinity purified rabbit IgG, VSV-g (E11) DB094, in 1 ml PBS containing 0.1 % sodium azide and 0.2% gelatin.

Specificity:

VSV-g (E11) is recommended for use by western blotting and immunoprecipitation. The suggested western blotting starting dilution is at 1:400.

Storage:

Store this product at 4° C, do not freeze. The product is stable for one year from the date of shipment.
